What is the overall deductible?	\$500 member/ \$1,000 family Benefits are administered on a calendar year basis.	Generally you must pay all the costs up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the policy, they have to meet their own individual deductible until the overall family deductible amount has been met.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes: durable medical equipment , emergency room care , prescription drugs, outpatient mental health services, preventive care , provider office visits, routine eye exams, are covered before you meet your deductibles .	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But, a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	\$2,500 member/ \$5,000 family	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limit until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.

Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters
What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> ?	Premiums, <u>balance-billing</u> charges, and health care this <u>plan</u> doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> .
Will you pay less if you use a <u>network provider</u> ?	Yes. See https://www.harvardpilgrim.org/public/find-a-provider or call 1-888-333-4742 for a list of <u>network providers</u> .	This <u>plan</u> uses a <u>provider network</u> . You will pay less if you use a <u>provider</u> in the <u>plan's network</u> . You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider</u> for the difference between the provider's charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays (<u>balance-billing</u>). Be aware, your <u>network provider</u> might use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider</u> before you get services.
Do you need a <u>referral</u> to see a <u>specialist</u> ?	Yes	This <u>plan</u> will pay some or all of the costs to see a <u>specialist</u> for covered services but only if you have a <u>referral</u> before you see the <u>specialist</u> .
